

For a successful purchase when buying vintage furniture follow this tips

Checklist

- ✓ Look for a label, mark o stamp. Although not always a miss of this means you are in front of a real gem.
- ✓ Look the piece all around for sings or woodworm.
- Spot the crews and joints to identufy if they are new or vinatge. It is clear sign to know if it is a copy.
- Check if the piece is robust or look for signs of glue to know if it has been repaired in the past.
- ✓ If you like pieces in their original finish, dont go for a painted one. It can be quite tricky to remove paint deppending on how it was applied.
